Scholarships Now Available

Scholarship applications for the 2024 HFS FCU Scholarship Program are now available! This year, fifteen (15) scholarships will be awarded worth \$3,000 each. Ten (10) scholarships are for graduating Big Island high school seniors and five (5) scholarships are for current college students. Applications are exclusively available online at hfsfcu.awardspring.com and must be submitted no later than February 29, 2024.

Any student who meets the following requirements is eligible to apply:

- Current HFS Federal Credit Union member with his/her own account in good standing prior to the application deadline
- Current Big Island high school senior or a current college student (not limited to a Big Island college or university)
- Student must attend an accredited Vocational-Technical School, College, or University full-time in a 2 or 4-year program in 2024-2025 (12+ credits)
- · Minimum 3.0 cumulative G.P.A.
- · Financial Need

Sacred Heart Affordable Housing Project

We had the unique opportunity to sponsor a unit for Hope Services Hawai'i's "Sacred Heart Affordable Housing Project." This project is the first affordable housing development dedicated to Kupuna. Located in Puna, the project sits on land adjacent to Sacred Heart Shelter, the micro-shelter village constructed to house those displaced by the 2018 Kilauea eruption. The development consisted of 12 modular efficiency studio units, each equipped with its own living space, kitchen, and bathroom, as well as a central pavilion and office.

As a sponsor, HFS furnished and decorated an entire unit, which included purchasing furniture, supplying the kitchen and household items, linen, window treatments, and much more. We are incredibly grateful to be a part of this special project.
